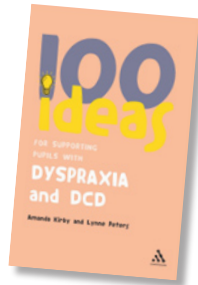


Professor Amanda Kirby founded The Dyscovery Centre in Cardiff over ten years ago. Since that time the Centre has become internationally recognised for its work in
