

BOUNDS

Pupils may visit Romsey with permission from their Housemaster/mistress, Deputy Headmasters or Headmaster in accordance with the pupil travel policy.

The pupils must stay within the School grounds at all times unless permission has been obtained from the abovementioned senior staff. The areas away from the lit pathways are Out of Bounds after dark.

The School grounds are particularly beautiful, and the peace and tranquillity afforded by such a setting can be therapeutic and of particular importance to a pupil under pressure from learning difficulties. However, potentially dangerous use of the grounds is not permitted. For example, trees are not to be climbed or to have rope swings erected from them; the lakes may be used for fishing but for no other activity.
